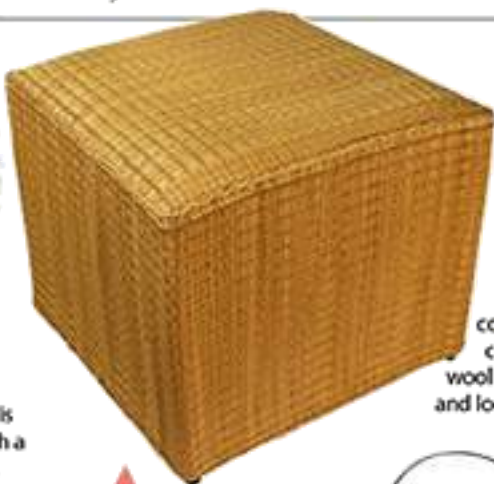


BOOKISH COMFORT
